

Terms & Conditions of “BOC Private Card - Up To HK\$300 Cash Rebate on Tesla EV Charging”:

1. Promotion period runs from now till 31 December 2025 (both dates inclusive) (the “Promotion Period”).
2. Unless otherwise specified, offer is only applicable to clients of BOC Private Card (the “Eligible Credit Card”) (the “Clients”) that is issued by BOC Credit Card (International) Limited (the “Company”) in Hong Kong.
3. During the Promotion Period, Clients can enjoy HK\$50 cash rebate by accumulating spending of HK\$500 or above (“Eligible Transactions”) in each calendar month at Tesla (the “Participating Merchant”) “Supercharging Station” or “Destination Charging Station” in Hong Kong and settle the payment with an Eligible Credit Card bound at Tesla mobile app (the “Offer”).
4. For each Eligible Credit Card, a maximum total of HK\$50 cash rebate will be granted in each calendar month whereas a maximum total of HK\$300 cash rebate will be granted for entire Promotion Period.
5. Offer is applicable to Tesla “Supercharging Station” and “Destination Charging Station” in Hong Kong listed at official website of Tesla (https://www.tesla.com/en_hk/) only.
6. The cash rebate will be credited to the Eligible Credit Card account automatically within 2 calendar months (excluding the month when the transactions are made) after successful accumulation of Eligible Transactions. For example, accumulated Eligible Transactions reach HK\$500 by 31 July, HK\$50 cash rebate will then be credited to the Eligible Credit Card account on or before 30 September.
7. All transactions will be counted based on the transaction date and only eligible transactions posted to Eligible Credit Card account within 7 days from the transaction date will be counted.
8. Offer is subject to limited quotas and available on a first-come-first-served basis while quotas last.
9. Clients’ Eligible Credit Card accounts must be normal, valid and in good standing during the Promotion Period in order to enjoy the Offer.

Any fraud and/or abuse of the Offer by any person (as determined by Bank of China (Hong Kong) Limited (the “BOCHK”) and the Company at their sole discretion) will result in forfeiture of the person’s eligibility to the Offer.
