Bank of China (Hong Kong) ("BOCHK") wishes to alert customers and the general public to a website that provides several downloadable fraudulent mobile applications.






When conducting transactions through electronic channels, customers are advised to access their Internet Banking or Mobile Banking accounts by typing the website address of BOCHK (www.bochk.com) directly in the browser address bar, or through the BOCHK Mobile Application downloaded from official App stores or reliable sources. Customers should not access such accounts or provide personal information (including passwords) through hyperlinks, QR codes or attachments embedded in e-mails or on websites. 

To verify any phone calls, e-mails, website addresses or mobile applications purporting to be from BOCHK, customers can also call the above Customer Service Hotline (press 8 after language selection).
