Notice on BOCHK Branch Services

Bank of China (Hong Kong) ("BOCHK") is committed to providing banking services to its customers while adjusting the branch service arrangements in response to the ongoing developments of the epidemic. From 6 April (Wednesday), 11 branches will resume services. These branches include: Connaught Road Central Branch, First Street Branch, Shun Tak Centre Branch, Siu Sai Wan Branch, North Point Branch, Chai Wan Branch Safe Box Service Centre, Kwong Fuk Road Branch, Ha Kwai Chung Branch, Kin Wing Street Branch, Tuen Mun Wealth Management Centre and Yuen Long (Hang Fat Mansion) Branch. The Bank has adopted a series of preventive measures at branches. Branch staff and customers entering branches are required to have their temperature taken and to wear a face mask. Those branches which had staff infected cases have been thoroughly cleaned and disinfected while staff resuming work at branches have tested negative for COVID-19.
