## **Statement on Fraudulent Video and Information**

Bank of China (Hong Kong) Limited ("BOCHK") would like to alert its customers and the general public to a fraudulent video purported to be sent from BOCHK on "Central registration and distribution of digital assets dividends". The video displays a BOCHK logo and falsely claims that the general public can register for receipt of dividends through the Bank. This video intends to deceive the general public into providing personal information or making investments. In addition, similar false information is also found online.

BOCHK declares that the aforementioned video and online information are fraudulent and unrelated to the Bank. BOCHK has reported the case to the Hong Kong Police Force. To avoid being scammed, the Bank advises its customers and the general public to remain vigilant, always verify the authenticity of online information, and not to provide anyone with sensitive personal information, Internet Banking account information and passwords.
