Statement on fraudulent websites and mobile applications

Bank of China (Hong Kong) Limited ("BOCHK") would like to alert its customers and the general public to the following fraudulent websites and mobile applications:

The fraudulent websites have a login page which intend to steal customers' data, such as the user mobile phone number and login password. The websites also have fraudulent BOCHK online chat. BOCHK declares that it has no connection with the fraudulent websites and mobile applications. Meanwhile, the case has been reported to the Hong Kong Monetary Authority and the Hong Kong Police Force.

When conducting transactions through electronic channels, customers are advised to access their Internet Banking or Mobile Banking accounts by typing the website address of BOCHK (www.bochk.com) directly into the browser address bar, or through the BOCHK Mobile Application downloaded from official App stores or reliable sources. Customers should not access such accounts or provide personal information (including passwords) through hyperlinks, QR codes or attachments embedded in e-mails or on websites.
