

"Support Fund for Wang Fuk Court in Tai Po" – Special Arrangements for Donors and Organizations by the Government

According to the information released by the Steering Committee of the "Support Fund for Wang Fuk Court in Tai Po", the Steering Committee would like to express its heartfelt gratitude to all individuals and organizations across society who have generously responded to the Government's appeal and contributed to the Fund. Each donation reflects genuine care and support for the affected residents.

The Government has implemented the following special arrangements for donors and organizations contributing to the "Support Fund for Wang Fuk Court in Tai Po":

1. Donation Appreciation Arrangement

The Government hopes to send letters of appreciation to donors or organizations to express its gratitude. Donors who wish to receive a letter of appreciation are kindly requested to register via the website: www.cefs.gov.hk/form/hab033/

2. Donation Receipts and Tax Deduction Arrangements

Under the Inland Revenue Ordinance, for donations of HK\$100 or more made throughout the year, donors are eligible for applying tax deduction. To facilitate tax deductions for donors, the government has made the following special arrangements for donors to the "Support Fund for Wang Fuk Court in Tai Po":

- Donors who made bank transfer of HK\$50,000 or less to the account of the "Support Fund for Wang Fuk Court in Tai Po", are not required to apply for a separate official donation receipt and can apply for tax deduction. However, donors must retain supporting records such as bank transfer or online transaction records, to prove that the donation was directly deposited from the donor's account to the designated account of the "Support Fund for Wang Fuk Court in Tai Po", so that they can be submitted for verification if the Inland Revenue Department conducts random audits in the future.

- Donors who made bank transfer or cash donations of HK\$50,000 or more, and wish to apply and obtain for an official donation receipt should visit www.taipofire.gov.hk/chi/taxdeduction.html for further details and to submit the application.
- Donations made through other charitable organizations rather than being made directly to the "Support Fund for Wang Fuk Court in Tai Po", please contact that respective charitable organization directly to obtain an official receipt.
